The total project cost is US\$ 103 Million, and it is designed to support small and medium-scale holdings in sub-sectors: Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Plantation, for addressing identified lapses along the value chain in farm to folk. The main objective of this 05 years project is to improve productivity, competitiveness and climate resilience of agri-food producers in the project areas. Applications are invited from citizens of Sri Lanka to fill the following position on a contract basis for the Project Management Unit (PMU). Basic Qualifications

1. Educational:

- Must have passed in six (06) subjects in a single sitting at the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination, with Credit passes for four subjects including (Sinhala / Tamil / English) Language and Mathematics.
- Must have passed three subjects at the G.C.E. (Advanced Level) Examination (excluding the Common General Test).

2. Age :

Should be between 18 - 45 years

Additional Qualifications

- i. Experience in a working with computer literacy.
- ii. Working experience in a similar post.
- iii. Typing skills of Sinhala/Tamil and English
- iv. Working experience in a foreign-funded project.
- v. Proficiency in English and knowledge on government rules and regulations.
